






Level - Seeker

Introductory level consisting of the *Green Quest* activity grid, 2 *Green Guardians* e-books and a list of recommended readings!




This compulsory level is free of charge and each child receives a complimentary ticket to the Conservatories and an e-certificate upon completion of the Seeker level!




Receive 2 exclusive *Green Guardians* e-books that will help children to learn about the sustainability efforts made by Gardens by the Bay.
