Sentosa As An Educational Destination



- •Home to historical sites, nature trails and wildlife, Sentosa offers a wide array of unique educational resources and learning journey programmes catered specially for our **Preschool, Primary and Secondary School Students** and are categorised based on broader themes such as **sustainability, science, experiential learning and history**.
- •Through our resources, Sentosa aims to equip students with knowledge beyond textbooks and classrooms, empowering their curious minds to explore, discover, experience and create.

Sentosa Kinder Explorer Learning Kit

- The Sentosa Kinder Explorer Learning Kit was specially created and designed for pre-schoolers (whom we call our Kinder Explorers!) to learn more about actions, emotions and objects through real-life examples in Sentosa.
- The learning kit can be used as a pre-, during and post-visit to Sentosa activity or simply as a standalone teaching resource to enhance learning in class.
- Co-created with PCF Curriculum Specialists, the learning kit consists of a teacher's manual, giant puzzle Sentosa map, Sentosa Express and bus figurine, 12 flashcards and a pair of inflatable dice.



My Sentosa Adventure – Saving Our Habitat

 Set in Imbiah Sentosa, students will travel virtually along the Imbiah Trail in this interactive video and be tasked to apply the knowledge acquired while exploring the flora and fauna of Sentosa to complete a mission.



Fort Siloso Virtual Tour

- Explore the only preserved coastal fort in Singapore, Fort Siloso, virtually and learn about WWII memorabilia, coastal guns, the remains of fortified military structures and tunnels.
- Easily accessible via Sentosa's website, students can now explore and deep dive into our past in the comfort of their classroom or home.

Lee Kuan Yew Fund for Bilingualism (LKYFB)

- LKYFB is funding SDC to produce a Chinese storybook. SDC has worked with Dr Cheng Wan Ni (Dean of Early Childhood Care and Education of the Singapore Centre of Chinese Language Limited, NTU) as well as author and illustrator 阿果老师 to create Bubu's Treasure Island.
- On track to complete the book in early 2022 and distribute to preschools and NLB by end 2022.

Outreach with Science Centre Singapore – UNTAME: Rebooting Our World

- UNTAME: Rebooting Our World is the 2nd edition of the annual STEM Festival for children, parents and educators. This year's theme focus on navigating through changing norms, sharing fresh perspectives empowered by STEM, and exploring a liveable and sustainable future together.
- Period: 6 Sep 5 Dec 2021; estimated to reach out to 40,000 participants across all the sub-events.
- SDC contributed 50 Kinder Explorer Kits and 2300 sets of worksheets on Flora and Fauna. We are also featuring 5 physical locations in Sentosa as well as a video featuring Sentosa, Sentosa Golf Club and Oasia Resort Sentosa's sustainability efforts in the interactive platform's gameplay, for participants to earn points.







Celebrating Our Grands 2021 with Families For Life

- Families For Life's annual 'Celebrating Our Grands' celebrates the strong bonds between multiple generations of the family. Celebrated a day after Children's Day, the nation-wide celebration hopes to inculcate important family values of 'Love', 'Care & Concern', 'Commitment' and 'Respect' in our young and encourage them to show appreciation for their grandparents or elderly extended family members in unique ways.
- From 9-10 Oct 2021, SDC supported with 2 sessions of Madame Tussauds Singapore's Virtual Images of Singapore virtual tour, giving 5 tickets as prizes for the grand winner.
- Total of 55 families attended the 2 sessions over the COG weekend.





SDC-SSDB 2022 Educational Resource (WIP)



Theme: Caring for our Family & Friends

Message: One for all, all for one. As the family takes care of me, I will do my part in helping and loving them in the ways I can.

Learning Outcome: To appreciate the support shown by one's family or community, and to inspire and motivate them to be supportive contributors themselves.

Resource would be a **picture & activity booklet**.

- Section 1: Twinning pictures
- Section 2: Completing missions

Section 1

Twinning pictures featuring the various ways parents take care of young children, followed by pictures of children in the foreground taking initiative. Examples:

- Parents cooking lunch for the children // Children taking out cutlery and setting the table
- Parents bringing children out to the beach // Children "teaching" them to have fun (teaching parents to build sandcastles, racing them, being a tour guide)

As the picture book has limited dialogue, children can be encouraged to vocalise and express what their role is in helping their family. A **pledge card** may be included for them to share their appreciation to their parents and one way they want to show their love and support in return.

Section 2

Missions that children and parents can do together, including:

Drawing, Reflections, Connecting the dots, Coloring pages, Origami/Craft-making
