The basic theory of service-learning is Dewey's: the interaction of knowledge and skills with experience is key to learning. Students learn best not by reading the Great Books in a closed room but by opening the doors and windows of experience. Learning starts with a problem and continues with the application of increasingly complex ideas and increasingly sophisticated skills to increasingly complicated problems" (Thomas Ehrlich, in: Barbara Jacoby and Associates. Service learning is not just about completing a task or project. It is about building relationships with the community and addressing real-world problems in a meaningful way. This requires a leader that values collaboration, empathy, and community engagement. It requires the HEART of a leader in order that everyone is taken care of. It's not just about the needs of the environment you are serving but the needs of everyone who is involved in making this world a better place.

3. EXAMPLE


Co-construct with your teachers, children, parents and community. MODEL collaboration and commitment so that your teachers, children and parents feel supported and valued.

Be sincere and empathise in everything that you say and do. Be kind to yourself but be kinder to others. Wear their shoes and walk your talk.


ETHICS OF EXCELLENCE





What I miss the most is my friends and teachers because they help me when I fall they Pick me up. What is the most fun memory in Fex is acting! because I find it, very fun and exciting.
