Join Becky Bunny as she discovers what it means to show Love, Care and Concern, Commitment and Respect to her family.





Take-Home Activities 2 activities for each level





Big Books focus on one of the four family values




- Stories center on the application of family values in the context of the family

· Mini-readers provided for children's independent in-class reading






• In-class activities are designed to help children consolidate learning of the family values

For NI upwards!



Started in 2018, Celebrating Our Grands (COG) is an annual celebration to encourage children to show love, care and concern, commitment and respect to elderly family members and build strong bonds with them, and instill family values from young. This year's COG will anchor on 7 Oct, one day after Children's Day.

Through the COG campaign, we:

- 1. Earmark the occasion as a special time to show appreciation for Grands
- 2. Encourage inter-generational bonding and forge closer family ties
- 3. Engage schools to involve children in a gift-making activity to gift the Grands

FFL will be distributing craft kits for preschoolers in August so that they can complete and present the craft to their Grands before 7 Oct. Preschools are also welcome to organise intergenerational bonding events and invite Grands to participate! Take photos of the crafts and any events and send them to us.
