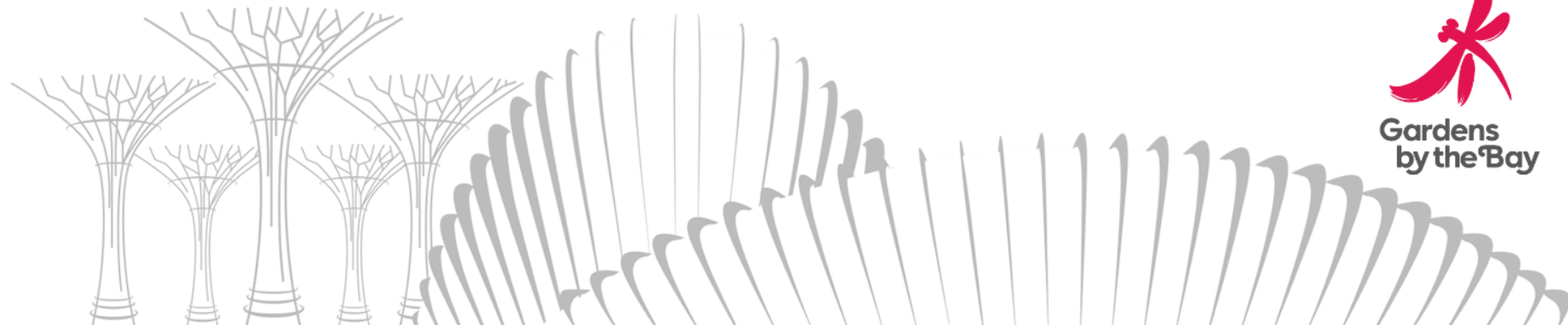

This compulsory level is free of charge and each child receives a complimentary ticket to an attraction at Gardens by the Bay and an e-certificate upon completion of the Seeker level!






# Seeker - Green Quest

Activities to complete (tick in the box upon completion of each task):

- Visit your neighbourhood library to borrow and read. Reduce, reuse, and recycle. Oscar! by Mary Lindell at Questions and Answers About Recycling and Rubbish by Katie Daynes, with an adult to learn why recycling is so important.
- Did you know that many types of animals call Gardens by the Bay home? Complete these *colouring sheets* to find out what these animals are!
- Complete the activity in *Letters to David, Super, Super, Trees* to learn about energy that comes from the sun!
- Reduce waste by reusing things that will normally be thrown away. Collect empty toilet roll tubes and press them into shapes you like. Then dip the ends in paint and use them as stamps!
- Growing your own food is good for the Earth because less energy is needed to get it to your plate! Follow these *instructions* to grow mung bean sprouts with your family and enjoy having them for a meal together!
- Read *A New Home for Dora & Eraddy* - back to find out what kind of plants are in and around Dragonfly Lane, Gardens by the Bay.
- Food that is grown in Singapore does not have to travel a long way to reach us. Visit the supermarket with an adult and search for one type of local produce. Take a photograph of this ingredient.
- Water is precious! It keeps us and other living things alive. Collect a bucket of rainwater on a rainy day and use this to water your house plants.
- Take a walk in a garden or park and photograph an interesting plant or animal you see. Share this photograph with a friend and explain why you like this plant or animal!

# Seeker – Green Guardians e-books



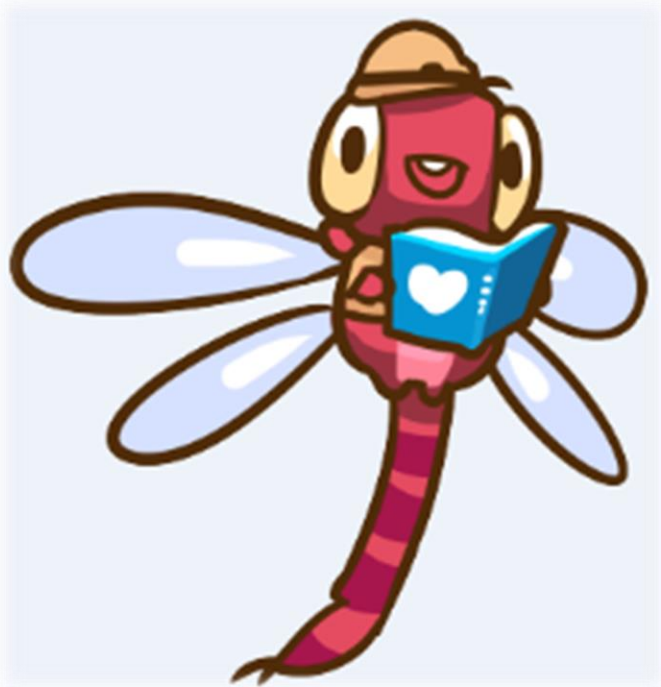
Receive 2 exclusive *Green Guardians* e-books that will help children to learn about the sustainability efforts made by Gardens by the Bay.

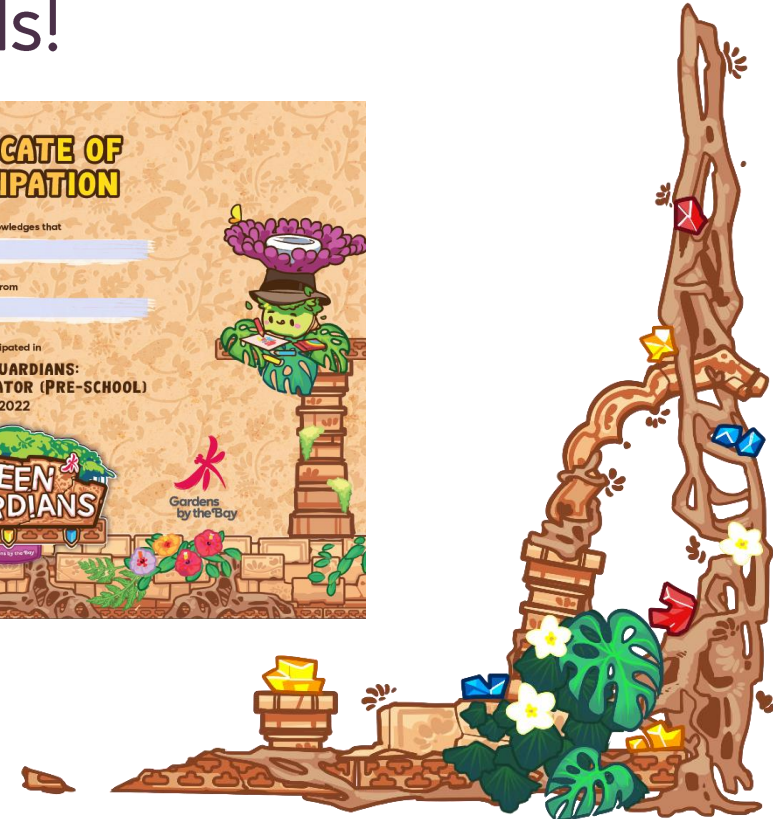

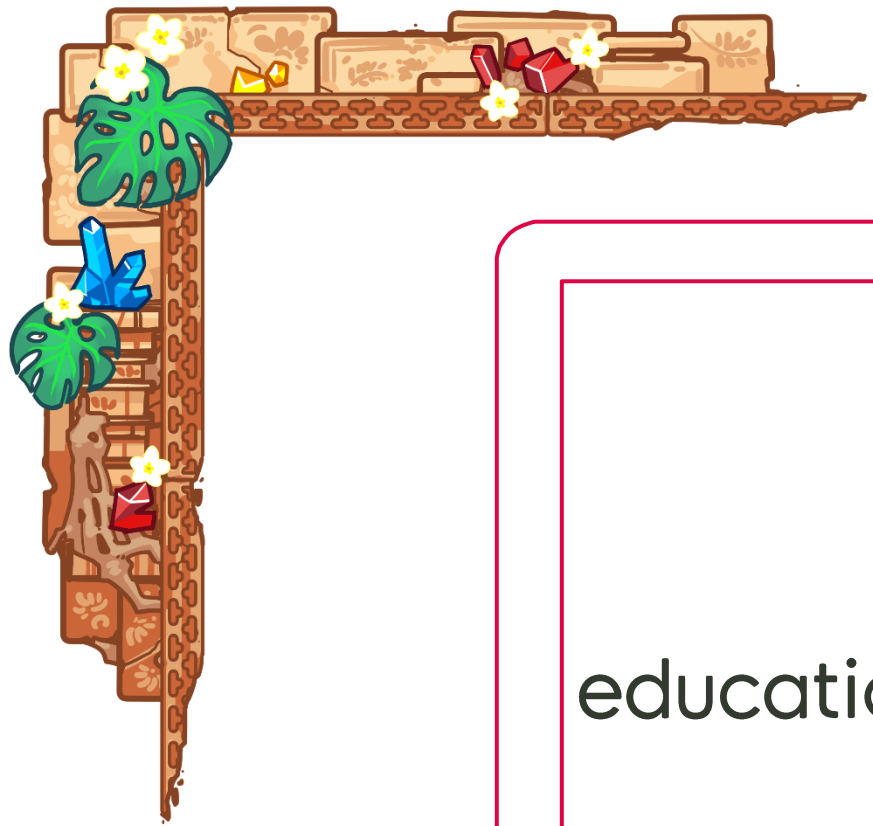

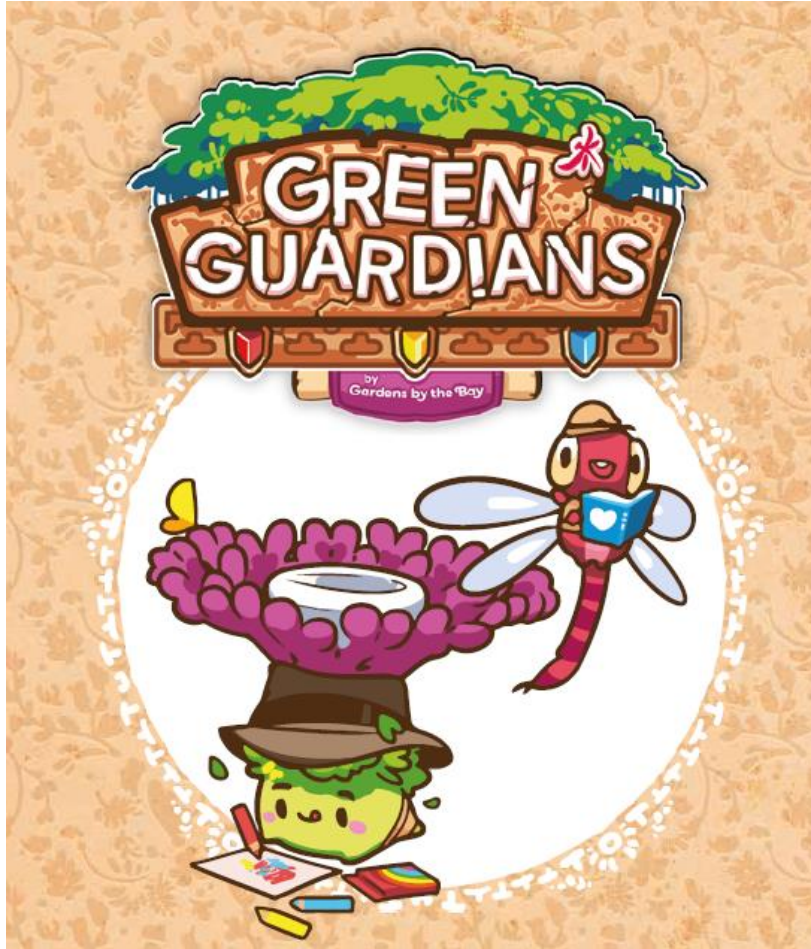
