

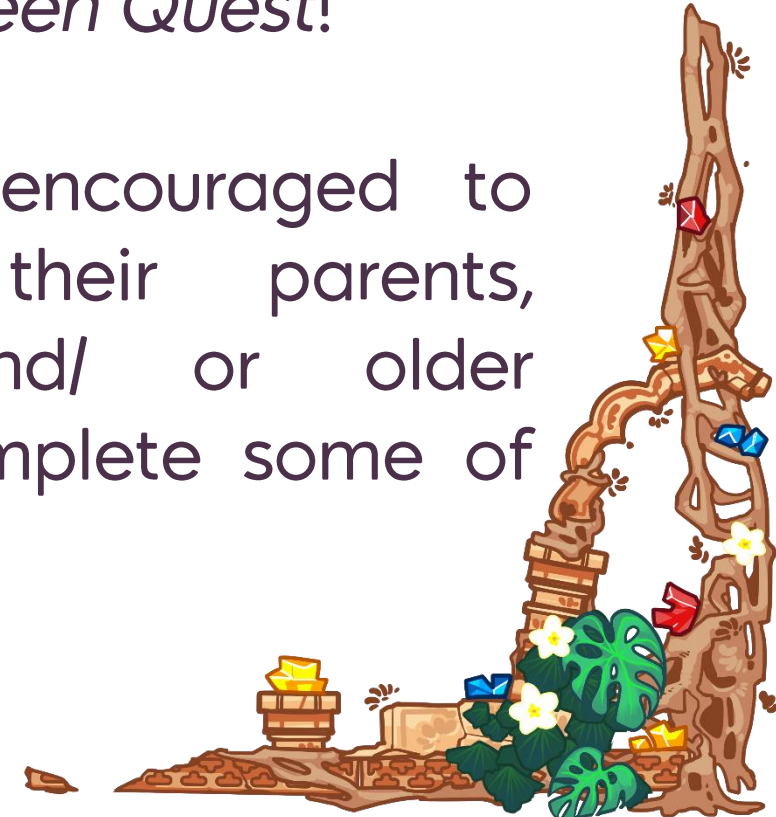

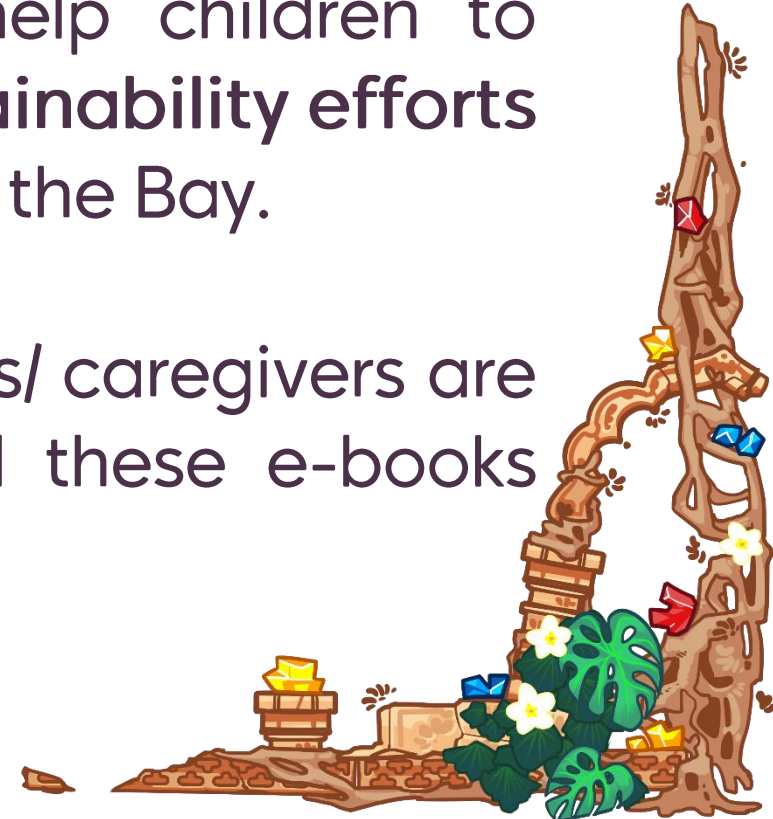


Seeker – Green Guardians e-books

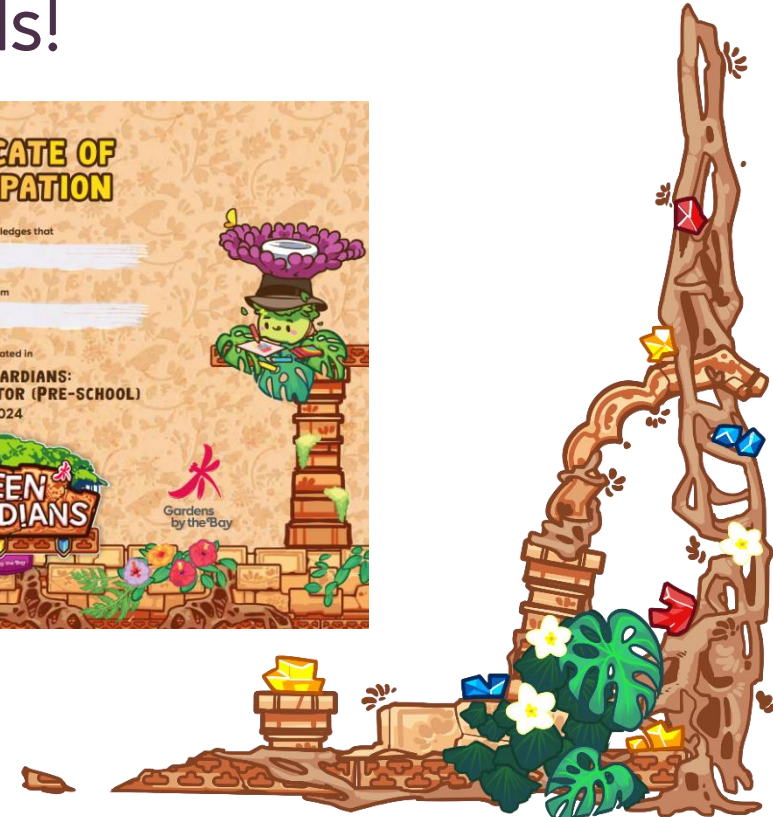
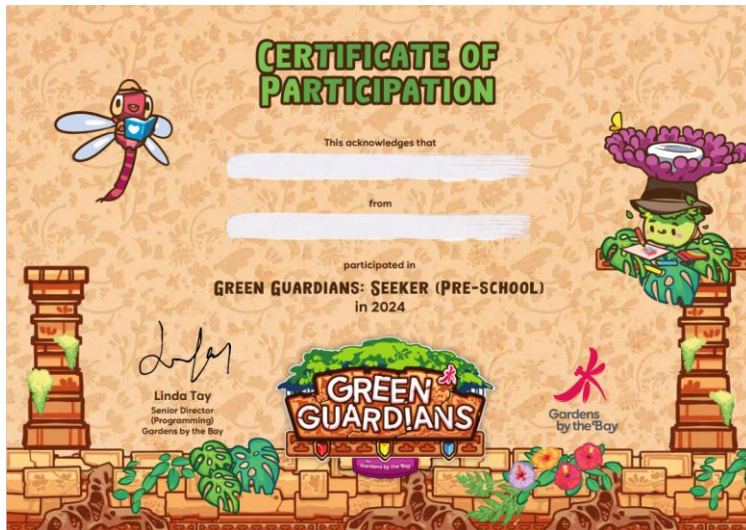


Dig Deep: Plant Habitats

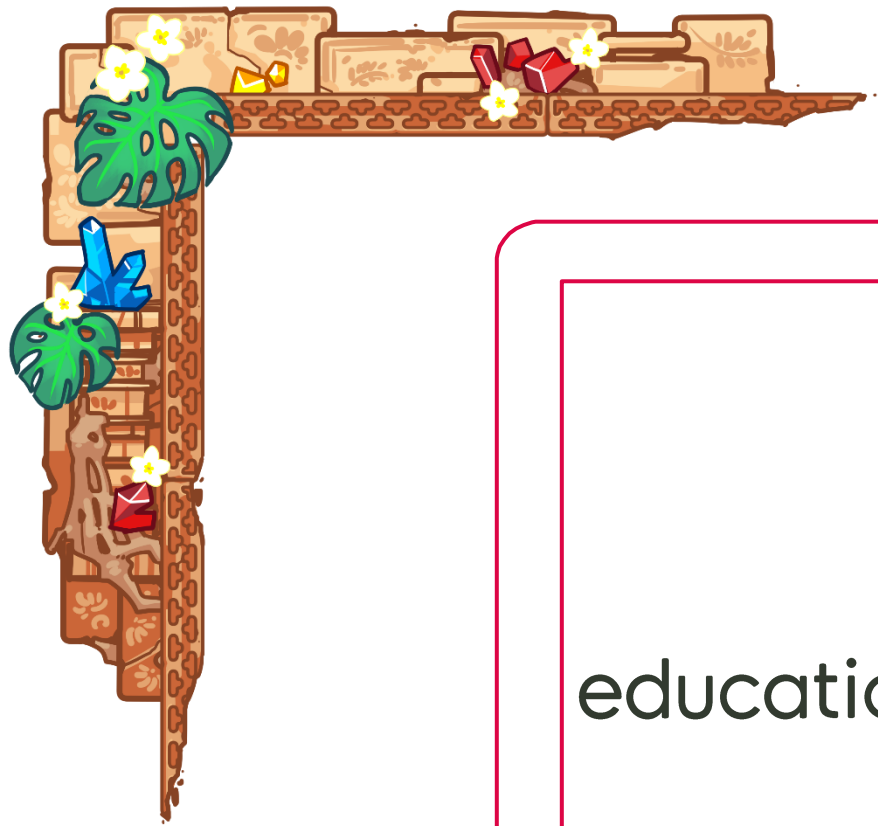


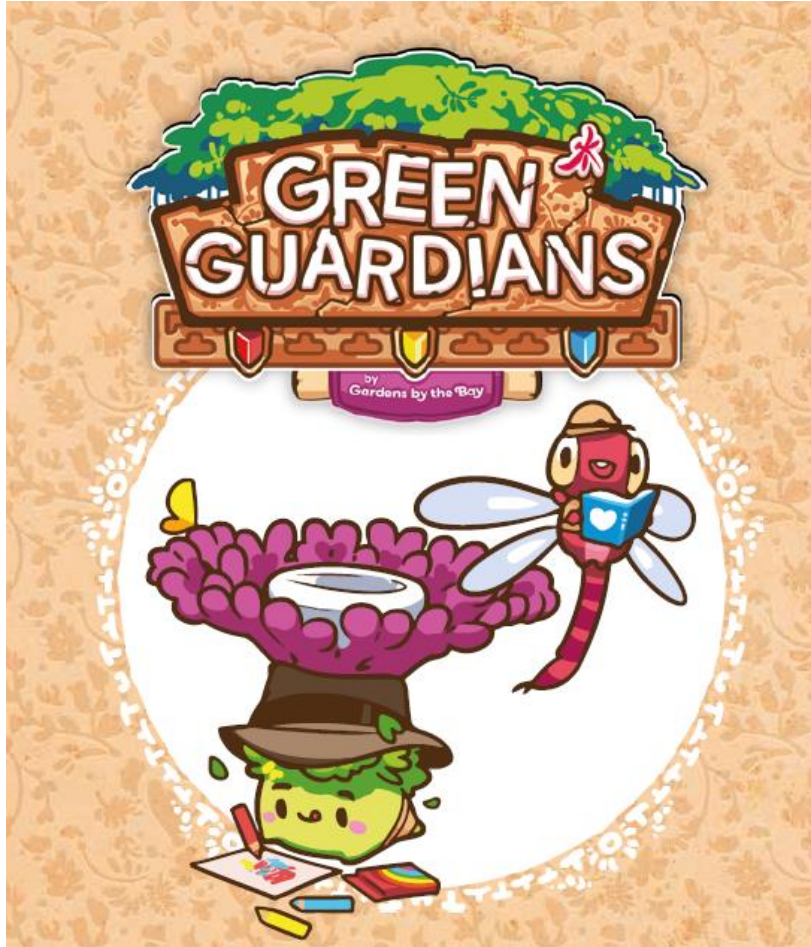
